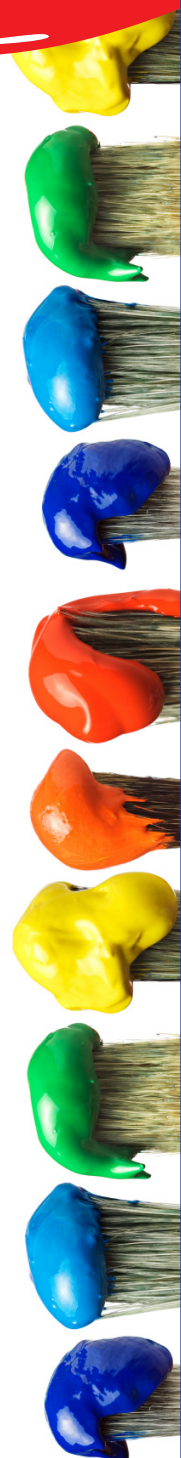
Membership dues are \$40 annually and are payable by January 31st each year. Those joining in the last quarter of any given year will receive benefits through the next calendar year.
